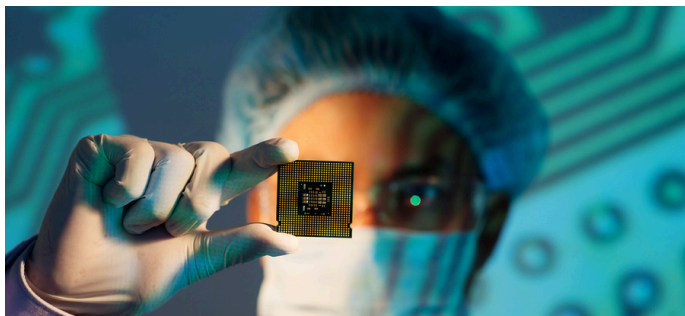
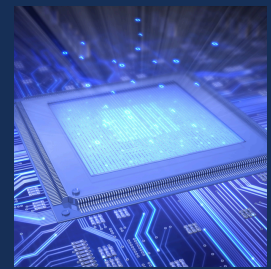


The Battery Blip: A Promising Pause in Brighton

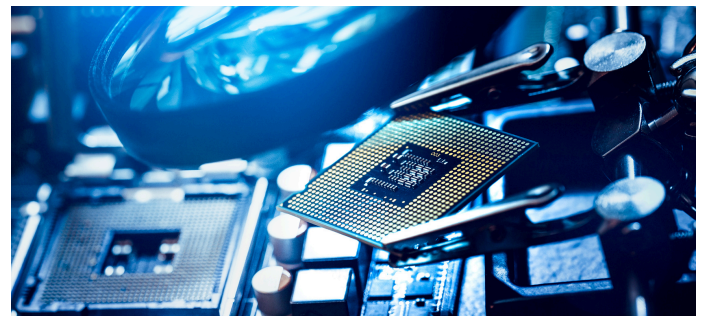
The Semiconductor Surge: Colorado's Chip Champions
